

LAST PLANTING DATES FOR SECOND-SEASON CROPS

To calculate the best time to plant your second vegetable crops, look at the first expected freeze dates in the chart below. Choose the date that comes closest to the expected first killing frost in your area. If you do not know the date, call your local county extension agent or go to our Web site at Almanac.com for more frost-date information.
